AVOCADO DEVILED EGGS

Pat Headley's eggs were a big hit at the Summer Picnic. Here's the recipe...Enjoy!

12 hard boiled eggs, peeled and separated Zest and juice of 1 lime 1 avocado, peeled and pitted salt and pepper

4 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled

2 sliced green onions

1/3 c Southwest Chipotle Dressing

Put yolks, zest, juice, avocado, salt and pepper in a food processor and pulse until the mixture is smooth. (I used an ordinary mixer and it worked just fine).

Put the mixture in a pastry bag and generously pipe into egg whites. Top with crisp bacon crumbles and sliced green onions. Add a sprinkle of chopped cilantro if desired.
